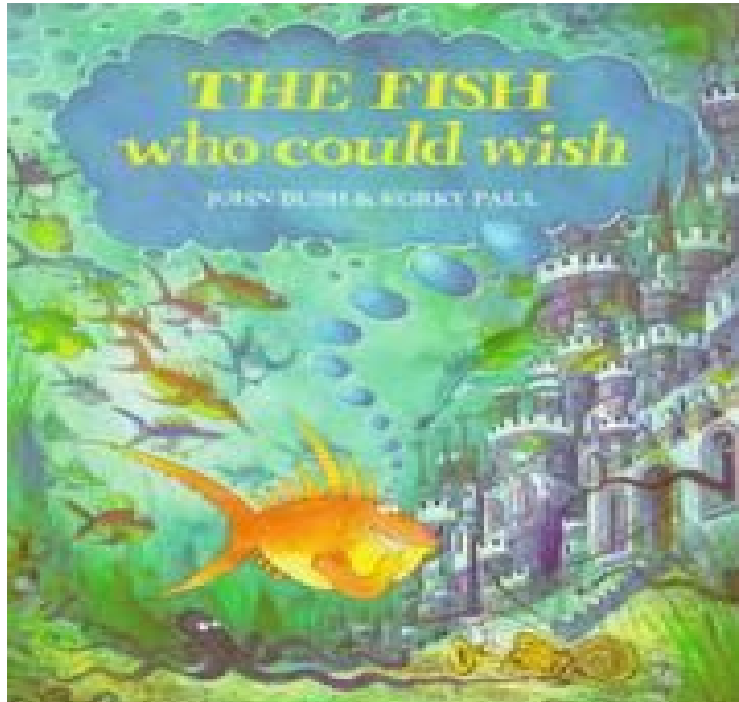


Home Learning with the Nursery ~ Week 1: 01/02/21

We'll be making: treasure boxes to hold our wishes. Why not find an old box to decorate? You could try to make a special name label for your wish box too.



To support our maths and counting: we'll be making shape fish and printing shapes



Remember all the funny shaped fish in the story?

- *Can you name all of the shapes?*
- *Can you find things around your home that are the same shape?*



We'll also be making: birthday cake pictures, adding our chosen number of candles (up to 6).

As an extended challenge, we will try to write the number and draw the dot number pattern (like on a dice)



How old are you? How many candles on your birthday cake? How many candles will you have on your next birthday cake?

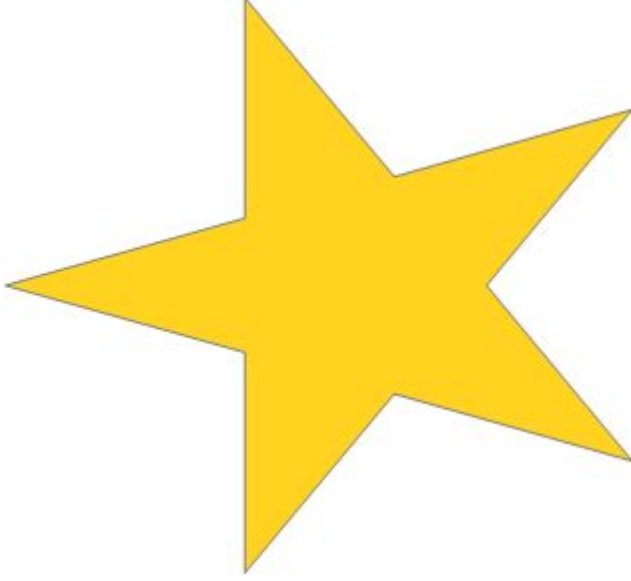

You have been granted 3 wishes!

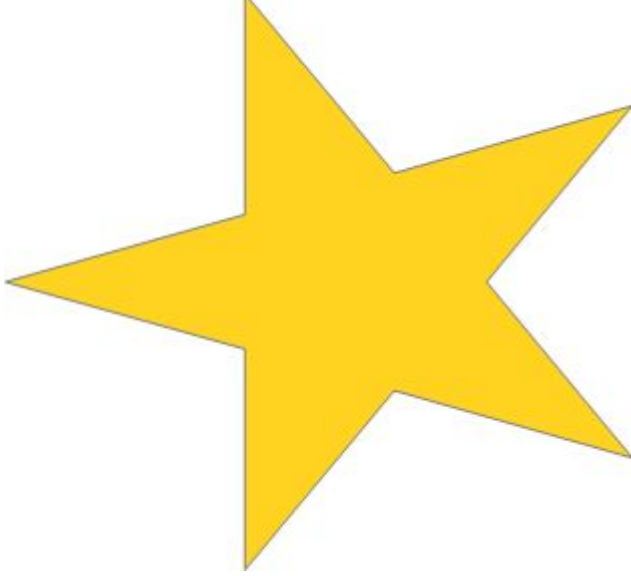
Talk to your family and ask them to help you write your wishes on the stars.

Maybe you could draw a picture of your wishes too?

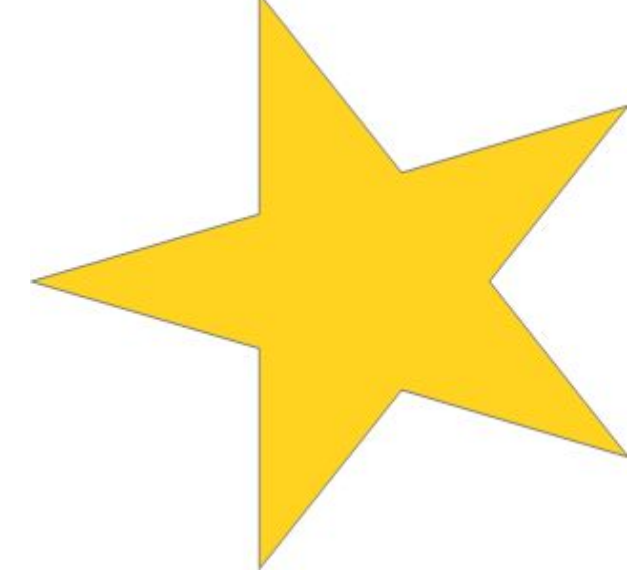
A wish for me
