



**We are looking forward to welcoming you to our stay and play in the Community Garden.**

**However If you answer yes to any of the following questions, please do not attend the Stay and Play.**

1. Have you or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the last 14 days?
  - A high temperature (>37.8C - feel hot to touch on back or chest)
  - A new, continuous cough (3 episodes of coughing in 24 hours or one hour of coughing)
  - A loss of or change to sense of smell or taste
2. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
3. Have you been in close contact with someone who has had any of the above symptoms, or has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?  
[Close contact: within 2 metres of someone for more than 15 minutes]
4. Has NHS Test & Trace contacted you in the last 14 days and asked you to self-isolate?
5. Have you returned from travel within 14 days from a country not on the UK quarantine exempt list?

**If you answered yes to any of these questions, please do not visit the setting**

## When you are attending the Stay and Play in the Community Garden

### PLEASE

- Sanitise your hands on arrival throughout the session - we have sanitiser available.
- The garden is an open area with uneven surfaces - please supervise your children at all times.
- The garden gate is on a latch - please ensure you close firmly behind you.
- Due to COVID guidelines we can only admit families into the garden who have made a booking for the session with us.
- Only one parent and child can attend the Stay and Play session
- We are sorry but you cannot bring a friend or relative with you who has not booked a place at the Stay and Play - show your friend how to book a Stay and Play session.
- There is no toilet in the community garden - please use the toilet before you come.
- Maintain 2m social distance from staff and other parents at all times, you do not need to maintain a distance from children.
- Keep your belongings with you at all times .
- Bring your own water bottle and healthy snack in a sealed container if you need it.
- You must sign in or use NHS track and trace QR code
- You do not have to wear a mask but can choose to if you wish
