

IMPACT REPORT 2022 SUBJECT: Music

1. KEY POINTS FROM SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (SDP)

- a) To ensure that pupils use instruments as part of music teaching.
- b) To provide high quality first access opportunities for pupils.
- c) To apply for the funding from Newham Music Trust to provide enrichment opportunities in the 2022/23 academic year.

2. PROGRESS AND IMPACT TO DATE

- a) Full Newham enrichment music grant received last year. Samba drums purchased so that years 4 and 5 could deliver their own samba lessons. Choir lead also paid from the grant funding.
- b) Teachers are more confident with teaching; coverage is good across the six weeks of lessons in the autumn term. Pupil conferencing was very positive and all children enjoyed music; they were able to talk using some music vocabulary and explain the genre that they had covered.
- c) Music lead to attend Newham Music Trust zoom session for ideas and music workshops that are available for the upcoming grant application.

3. LOOKING AHEAD

- a) Music leader to attend Charanga training for the new model music scheme. Any changes to the scheme to be implemented and training provided for all teachers.
- b) A Ukulele after school club to start in the Autumn term led by Miss Storey
- c) Choir will continue for the rest of the year with performances planned for key events in the Summer term.
