Equality, Diversity and Inclusion

Maryland is committed to equality, diversity and inclusion. We aim for a harmonious environment and as part of our community, these values underpin everything we do. Whilst equality, diversity and inclusion are closely related, and often discussed as a single concept, it is useful to consider the individual terms and their meanings.

- Equality means that everyone is treated the same, is treated
 fairly and has the same opportunities. Equity is slightly different
 from equality in that it recognises that each person has different
 circumstances. This means that varying types or levels of support
 might be required, depending on individual need, to take full
 advantage of equal opportunities.
- Diversity means recognising, respecting and welcoming everyone's different backgrounds, identities and experiences. Promoting diversity celebrates people's differences and uniqueness.
- **Inclusion** means that everyone is encouraged to retain their uniqueness, they aren't singled out for being different, and have a sense of belonging and being valued.
